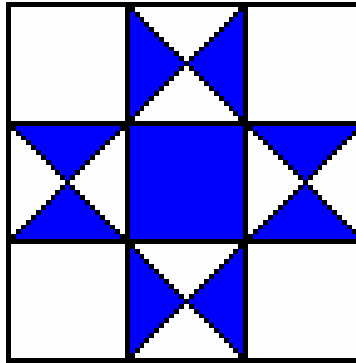


QCNNY Block of the Month

Oh My Stars! # 1—OHIO STAR



NOTE: You can use your own method to make four 4 1/2" unfinished quarter squares triangles, or use the easier directions and templates found at <http://www.quilt.com/Blocks/TrianglePapers/Triangles.html> We will have copies of these templates and directions at the September meeting. **Use the following directions if you are NOT using the templates; otherwise, follow the directions on the template webpage for 4" finished quarter square triangles.**

Fabric/Colors

Fabric 1 Dark Brown (think *chocolate!*)

Fabric 2 Gold (think *butterscotch!*)

Cutting





For the Squares:

1. Cut one 4 1/2" strip of Fabric 2
2. Cut one 4 1/2" square from the Fabric 1
3. Cut four 4 1/2" squares from the Fabric 2 strip

For the Quarter Squares:

1. Cut one 5 1/4" strip of each Fabric 1 and Fabric 2
2. Cut two 5 1/4" squares from each of the Fabric 1 and the Fabric 2 strips
3. Cut each 5 1/4" square in half on the diagonal
4. Cut each triangle in half on the diagonal. This will result in 8 Fabric 1 and 8 Fabric 2 quarter triangles .

Piecing the Ohio Star Block

1. Piece 8 Fabric 1 triangles to 8 Fabric 2 triangles. 
2. Piece the triangles created in step 1 together to form a square. 
3. Piece 4 squares of Fabric 2 together with 2 triangular squares to form 2 strips 
4. Piece 2 triangular squares with 1 square of Fabric 1 to form 1 strip 
5. Piece the 3 strips together to form the completed Ohio Square quilt block
