

QCNY 2007-08 Raffle Quilt  
Black/White Adinkra

These directions make two 8 ½ in" squares. Please use 100% cotton fabrics. All seam allowances should be ¼ inch.<sup>1</sup>

⇒PLEASE BRING BLOCKS TO THE MAY & JUNE GUILD MEETINGS. IF YOU CAN, IT WOULD HELP FOR YOU TO MAKE FOUR BLOCKS

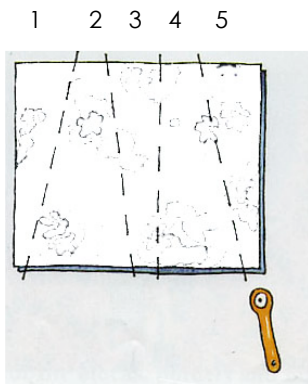
**MATERIALS:**

white on black fabric (black fabric with white design).

white "tone on tone" fabric. (If you don't have white tone on tone, you can use black on white, but make sure that there is significantly more white than black in this print.)

- 1). Cut one 11-inch square of white on black fabric and one 11-inch square of the white tone on tone.
- 2). Place the squares one on top of the other with right sides up and press.
- 3). Place the squares on the cutting board, still with right sides up and one on top of the other. Using a rotary cutter and a ruler—but without measuring—make four cuts through the two fabrics as in diagram 1. The exact position and angle of your cuts will vary somewhat

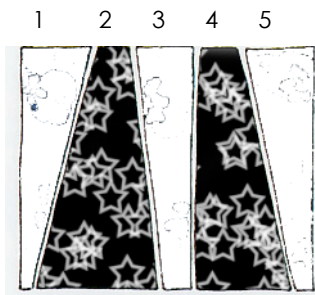
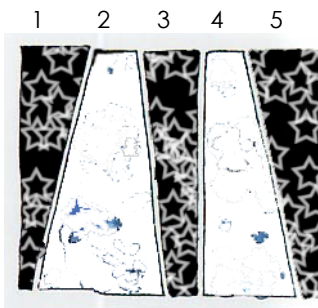
Now you have 5 pieces of fabric on each layer

- 4). Separate the top fabric pieces from the bottom fabric pieces, keeping them in the same order.

Rearrange the strips so that pieces 1,3 and 5 of the top fabric are teamed up with 2 and 4 of the bottom fabric and 1,3 and 5 of the bottom fabric are teamed with 2 and 4 of the bottom fabric (see diagram 2).

**These are your two blocks:**

4. Stitch the four seams in each block and press the seams towards the black fabric.
5. To complete the block, trim the blocks to 8½" squares.
